Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the management of Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) are complying with statutory provision of Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) Act, 1952 (Sections 40, 40A, 59, 72 and 73) and Employees Pension Scheme, 1995 (Sections 17A and 223);
- (b) if so, the details of RRBs, Statewise;
- (c) the details of RRBs filed to pay the balance of Provident Fund and Pension to the staff members who have retired or expired during the last three years, State-wise; and
- (d) the Provident Fund and Pension Fund balance of each RRBs as on 31 March, 2010 lying with Provident Fund Commissioner on the part of employer and employee?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a): Yes, Madam. The Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) are covered under the Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.

(b): Details are as per statement at Annexure-I.

(c): Payment of Provident Fund and Pension to employees of a covered Regional Rural Bank is not effected directly by the bank but it is disbursed through field offices of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation. However, Provident Fund of exempted Regional Rural Banks is disbursed to its employees directly by the Provident Fund Trust of the Bank. The State-wise details of RRBs, which have failed to pay the balance of Provident Fund and Pension to their staff members who have retired or expired are not maintained.

(d): The information is available as on 31st March, 2009 which is as per statement at Annexure-II.

- (a) the details of the progress in issue of Kisan Credit Cards (KCC);
- (b) whether Kisan Credit Card has been issued to all the farmers in the country;
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the steps being taken by Government to expedite the process?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE

(SHRI NAMO NARAIN MEENA)

(a) to (d) : The Kisan Credit Card (KCC) Scheme was introduced in 1998-99, as an innovative credit delivery system aiming at adequate and timely credit support from the banking system to the farmers for their cultivation needs, including purchase of inputs in a flexible, convenient and cost effective manner. The Scheme is being implemented by all the Scheduled Commercial Banks throughout the country. National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) has reported that as on 28 February 2010, the banking system has issued 906.37 lakh KCCs (since inception). Commercial Banks accounted for the highest share (43.91%), followed by Co-operative Banks (41.66%) and Regional Rural Banks (14.43%). KCC scheme was simplified in consultation with RBI in 2004 to cover all eligible farmers including small and marginal farmers, oral lessees, tenant farmers, etc. However, to make the scheme more effective at ground level and to better serve the farmers the Government of India has constituted a Task Force to, inter alia, examine and suggest measures for improving the efficiency of the KCC scheme, including the revised operational guidelines for distribution and sanction of the KCC limit.
