Attention is drawn to Head Office letter No.Pension-I/12/33/EPS Amendment/96 Vol.II/13979 dated 19.12.2017.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court vide its order dated 10.04.2018 vacated the interim stay granted on 15.12.2017 and requested the concerned High Courts to deal with the matters on merits. The Hon'ble Supreme Court accordingly disposed the Transfer Petitions and all pending applications. (copy of the order is enclosed)

In light of the above order it is requested to take the following actions.

- i) To defend the cases filed by employees of exempted establishments against EPFO seeking quashing of circular letter No. Pension-I/12/33/EPS Amendment/96/Vol.II/4432 dated 31.05.2017 and praying for allowing option to contribute retrospectively on Higher Wages exceeding the statutory limit under the deleted proviso to Para 11 (3) of Employees Pension Scheme 1995.
- ii) The counter reply in all such Writ Petitions may be prepared and forwarded to Head Office through ACC Zone for vetting sufficient in advance. The instructions laid down in circular No. LC-9(12)2013/CPFC Ref./Pt./3865 dated 16.05.2014 and sub-sequent circulars must be followed
