**Sub: Supplying of Information under RTI Act, 2005-Reg.**

Whereas an application under the RTI Act, 2005 in respect of Sh. Divyanshu Singh has been received in Head Office for supplying information under the Act.

2. And Whereas on scrutiny of the application (copy enclosed), it is found that the information sought by applicant on points 3 and 4 is related to field offices.
3. Therefore, in accordance with Section 6(3) of RTI Act, 2005 the application is being transferred to all field offices for supplying the desired information directly to the applicant.
4. It may be mentioned that if the desired information does not pertain to the concerned division or public authority or some part of information is held by other division or public authority, the concerned CPIO shall forward/transfer the application or such part of it as may be appropriate to relevant division/Public authorities u/s 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 and inform the applicant immediately/about such transfer. However, if the CPIO is not able to find out as to which division/public authority is concerned with the information even after making reasonable efforts to find out the concerned division/public authority to which the application could be transferred. It would, however be the responsibility of the CPIO, if an appeal is made against this decision, to establish that he made reasonable efforts to find out the particulars of the concerned division/public authority.
5. The name and address of the Appellate Authority may also be mentioned in the reply, so that the applicant can make an appeal within 30 days from the expiry of such period or from the receipt of decision given by the public authority, if he is aggrieved by the decision.
6. This may please be treated as most urgent.

2. While furnishing information, it may please be noted that the requisite fees have to be charged as per Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions Notification F.No.34001/8(s)/2005-Estt. (B) Dated 16th September 2005, which has been circulated by Adm.III Section, vide their letter no. Z.01015/1/2005-Adm.III.

3. If the desired information do not pertain to the concerned division or some part of information is held by other division or public authority, the concerned CPIO shall forward/transfer the application or such Part of it as may be appropriate to relevant division/Public authorities u/s 5(4) and 6(3) of the RTI Act, 2005 respectively and inform the applicant immediately about such transfer. However, if the CPIO is not able to find out as to which division/public authority is concerned with the information even after making reasonable efforts to find out the concerned division/public authority, he should inform of the particulars of the concerned division/public authority to which the application could be transferred. It would, however, be the responsibility of the CPIO, if an appeal is made against his decision, to establish that he made reasonable efforts to find out the particulars of the concerned division/public authority.

4. If some part of the information is the concern of a public authority under any State Government or the Union Territory Administration, the CPIO receiving the application should inform the applicant that the information may be had from the concerned State government/UT Administration. Application, in such a case, need not be transferred to the State government/UT Administration.

5. Name & Address of the Appellate Authority may also be mentioned in the reply, so that the applicant can make an appeal within thirty days from the expiry of such period or from the receipt of decision given by the public authority, if he is aggrieved by the decision.
