In the evolving landscape of businesses, various aspects in the domain of Compliance warrant rationalisation, standardisation & innovation to strike a balance between legal requirements & practical exigencies.

- 2. With the above view, ten (10) separate teams have been constituted on the directions of CPFC and a brief overview of each area along with an indicative scope of reference is enclosed for all for ready reference.
- 3. Accordingly, each of the working groups will undertake brainstorming in the area of study assigned to it as indicated in the enclosures. At the outset, the time frame for the completion of the work by the respective working groups shall be sixty (60) days from the date of introductory meeting. By the end of which, compilation of detailed draft SOP/s for the respective segment as well as any draft circular/s that would be required for the implementation of the respective efforts, may also be demonstrated / presented for the necessary approval of the competent authority.
- 4. An introductory meeting in this regard shall be held in virtual mode on 15 th, December 2022 at 3 P.M. and further details shall be conveyed in the meeting.
