# SOCIAL SECURITY CODE, 2020

Main Features and Comparative Analysis With Existing Laws

COURSE CODE: SSC062023

The Code on Social Security, 2020 consolidates the provisions of the existing nine central regulations related to workers' benefits like Provident Fund, Pension, Health, Employment, Maternity, Gratuity, etc. into one. The code aims to extend social security benefits to all employees and workers whether belonging to the organised sector or the unorganised sector, The coverage of the social security umbrella has been extended comprehensively towards the self-employed workers, home workers, wage workers, migrant workers, the workers in the unorganised sector, gig workers and platform workers for the purpose of social security schemes, including life insurance and disability insurance, health and maternity benefits, provident fund.

The enactment may significantly impress upon the reach and responsibilities of the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation as the country's prominent social security service provider. The officers of EPFO thus, would require to be abreast of the provisions of the code and also understand the incorporated amendments. Critical evaluation of the new additions and comprehensive understanding of the social protection case for it may further strengthen the cause. The emphasis is to be upon comparative study of existing versus new provisions and also to be upon the legal changes which may demand significant amendment in the work process or the practices established in the EPFO since the last 70 years when the EPF & MP Act, 1952 was promulgated.

The course is exclusively designed for only EPFO officials.

Participants who successfully complete the course will receive a Certificate of Completion.
