The Committee took a firm stand that in any case the Receipt and payment Accounts of the Regional Sports Promotion Boards should reach to the Head office by 30 <sup>th</sup> April of each year. All the Regional Commissioners/Presidents Regional Sports Promotion Boards to ensure strict compliance of the above instructions.
