1. General Conditions:

- 1.1 Tender shall be submitted in official tender form only. If submitted in any other form the same shall be summarily rejected.
- 1.2 The service provider shall provide direct service and shall not employ sub-contractors.
- 1.3 The Agencies can inspect the site and equipment's with the AC Technician after taking prior approval between 10 am to 5 pm on all working days on or before the closing date of receipt of the tender.
- 1.4 Sealed offers are invited for the Annual Maintenance contract of different type of split Air Conditioner units of different capacities.
- 1.5 Corrections, if any in the tender must be attested by the tenderer.
- 1.6 EPFO reserves the right to reject all or any tender wholly or partly without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- 1.7 Late tenders will not be considered and shall be rejected.
- 1.8 The rates quoted should be on FIRM & FIXED basis.

2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)

- 2.1 The tender should be accompanied with an earnest money deposit of Rs 10,000/- (Rs Ten Thousand only) application in the form of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque of Scheduled Bank drawn in favour of "**The Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, Vapi**". No Cheques are acceptable.
- 2.2 Technical bids without Earnest Money Deposit will be rejected. EMD will be forfeited in case the eligible bidder withdraws during the tender section process.
- 2.3 The parties enjoying exemption for paying EMD should enclose necessary certificate/documentary evidence for the same in accordance to the recent amendment in GFR. **Bid security to remain valid for a period of 90 days beyond the final bid validity period.**

2. Eligibility Conditions

- 3.1 Tenderer must submit a copy of GST, PAN, Shop & Estt. and other Government registration Certificate which should be in the name of the tenderer.
- 3.2 Bid should be completed, covering the entire scope of the work and should conform to the General and Special conditions indicated in the bid document. Incomplete and non-conforming bids will be outrightly rejected.
- 3.3 The tenderer should submit **separate envelop for Technical Bid and Financial Bids** in the enclosed formats with tender form respectively. The technical evaluation will be done as per technical bid. Financial bids will be opened only of those bidders who fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down in the Technical Bid.
- 3.4 Bidder should have a minimum of three years of experience in the service/maintenance of split Type Air Conditioners to various organizations.
- 3.5 A list of organizations where the Contractor is currently providing/has provided AMC of Split AC should be enclosed with the tender, alongwith copy of work orders/contracts.

- 3.6 Service providers should furnish PAN, GST Registration & other statutory requirements, if any as applicable.
- 3.7 Self attested copy of documentary proof submitted as required above must be furnished along with technical bid Part-1 and in case the required information and documents with the technical bid are not furnished, the tender shall be rejected.

4. The Tender is consisting of two parts:

PART-I- TECHNICAL BID

PART II- FINANCIAL BID

- 4.1 The tender form for Technical bid prescribed in Part-I and the tender form for the financial bid prescribed in Part-II complete in all respects should be enclosed in two separate sealed covers and both these sealed covers must be put inside a single sealed bigger cover and submitted to the **Regional Provident Fund Commissioner, CM 8/5 Snehdeep Commercial Complex, Gunjan Vapi-396195** on or before. The inner sealed covers shall be superscribed with **"Technical Bid"** and **"Financial Bid"** respectively and outer sealed cover shall be superscribed with **"Tender for Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract of Split type air conditioners."**
- 4.2 The tenderer must be placed in a properly sealed envelope addressed to **"The Regional provident Fund Commissioner, Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, CM 8/5 Snehdeep Commercial Complex, Gunjan Vapi-396195"** and the said bigger envelope shall contain two sealed envelopes containing Technical & Financial bids.
- 4.3 Bids prepared by the tenderer shall contain all requisite information along with self-attested supporting documents as per details in Technical Bid- part I
- 4.4 The tenderer or their authorized representative (One person only) may be present at the time of opening of the tender. The authorized representative shall be allowed to participate in the process only upon furnishing the proper authorization from the tenderer with proper photo identification.
- 4.5 Technical bids will be opened at the first instance by a committee of officers of EPFO on in the presence of bidders at **Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, CM8/5, Snehdeep Commercial Complex, N H 8, Gunjan, Vapi-396195**. Incomplete bid documents will be rejected.
- 4.6 In selecting technically suitable parties, the decision of EPFO will be final and binding. At the second stage, financial bids of only technically qualified bidders will be opened.
- 4.7 The financial bids of the participants which are found to meet all the requirements as specified in the Technical bid.
- 4.8 While submitting the tender, any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any form, the tender are liable to be rejected.
- 4.9 Any cutting/over writing etc. in the tender must be signed by the person who is signing the tender. Conditional Tenders will not be accepted and are liable to be rejected.

- 4.10 The Successful bidder has to execute an agreement for the above contract with the EPFO incorporating the prescribed terms and conditions in a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate denomination before commencing of works along with Security Deposit as per GFR 2017.

5. Criteria for Award of Contract

- 5.1 The Tender shall be awarded on completion of all terms and conditions required to be qualified by the bidder as per Technical bid and on the basis of total cost/value of the tender being the lowest i.e.L-1.
- 5.2 Nothing extra shall be paid on account of any discrepancy in nomenclature of items. The tenderer shall seek clarification if any before submitting the tender.
- 5.3 The tenderer agrees that the rates submitted shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of Technical Bid of tender.
- 5.4 The AMC Contract will be awarded for a period of one year from the date of awarding the contract. The period of AMC can be extended for another one year based on mutual agreement/contract.
- 6 The tenderers must thoroughly inspect the systems and furnish their quotes in "as is where is" condition without stipulating any preconditions.
- 7 After opening of technical bids, if necessary a technical team may inspect the infrastructure of the firm for verification and further action.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. Organisation shall mean 'Employees' Provident Fund Organisation, Regional Office-Vapi CM 8/5 Snehdeep Commercial Complex, N H 8, Gunjan, Vapi-396195 being present location and shall include their legal representatives, successors and permitted assigns.
2. The bids should be valid in the case of all the tenders for at least 90 days from the date of opening of the tender. In the case of the successful tenderer, rates quoted shall be valid for the entire period of the contract.
3. The contractor or his representative should not remove, disturb, and dislocate and existing equipment and its parts from its positions until and unless it is authorized by this office.
4. The entire installation shall be intact at any time of inspection as was handed over to him at the time of initial taking over of its maintenance and operation. Care shall also be taken not to damage installations by improper handling.
5. The Contractor shall inspect and examine the Site and its surrounding and shall satisfy himself before submitting his tender as to the nature of the Site, the quantities and nature of works and material necessary for the providing the services.
6. The Contractor shall be deemed to have satisfied himself before tendering as to the Correctness and sufficiency of his tender for the works and of the rates and prices quoted in the Schedule of Quantities, which rates and prices shall except as otherwise provided, cover all his obligations under the contract and all matters and things necessary for the proper completion and maintenance of the works.

7. Taking over of Air Conditioners for AMC

- 7.1 The air conditioners shall be taken over for AMC contract on "as and where installed" basis.
- 7.2 The contractor shall ensure that all Air Conditioners are in proper working conditions at the time of taking over.
- 7.3 After completion of the contract, contractor has to hand over the system in perfect running condition (complete in all respects as per inventory) to the department.

8. Commencement of Work

The contractor is required to start the work immediately from the date of award/date of communication of acceptance of the tender. In case it is found that the work has not been taken up within ten days from the date of acceptance of the tender or issue of the work order, the EPFO may cancel the work order.

9 Renewal of the contract

After expiry of the AMC of one year, the agency/contractor may be required to provide AMC services for subsequent year also which can be extended further on satisfactory performance of the previous year of the contract. However, the Organisation reserves the right to enter into AMC for another year on the same terms and conditions provided the services rendered by the bidder are satisfactorily.

10. The rates of AMC shall be inclusive of all taxes, duties, works contract tax, cartage loading, sales tax turnover tax and any other statutory taxes and service tax complete in all respects, valid for a period of one year from the date of award of contract.
11. The tenderer shall take into account basic price, cost of labour, T & P, taxes as applicable, conveyance/cartage etc, before quoting the rates. No extra claim what so ever in this regard shall be entertained. Parties are required to quote there PAN no, TIN No, GST, ESI Code and PF Code.

12. PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 12.1 The payment to the agency will be made on quarterly basis at the end of each quarter against invoice with PAN number raised by the agency and based on past performance. TDS and any other tax as applicable as per prevailing rates will be deducted before making the payment. Quarter shall mean three months.
- 12.2 The maintenance charges quoted by the agency per item are on yearly basis inclusive of all taxes and levies applicable. No escalation of prices shall be permitted on any ground in the period of contract agreement.

13. LABOUR:

- 13.1 The Contractor shall employ its labour in sufficient numbers to maintain the required rate of progress and of qualify to ensure workmanship of the degree specified in the Contract and to the satisfaction of the EPFO. The Contractor shall not employ in connection with the Works any person who has not completed eighteen years of age.
- 13.2 All the workers or employees deployed by the contractors shall be considered the employees of contractor and EPFO shall not have any liability what so ever in nature in regard to such workers/employees.
- 13.3 The Contractor shall pay to labour employed by him directly wages not less than fair wages as per minimum wages Act. Fair Wages means wages, which shall include wages for weekly day of rest and other allowances whether for time or piece work, after taking into consideration prevailing market rates for similiar employment in the neighbourhood but shall not be less than the minimum rates of wages fixed under the payment of Minimum Wages Act.
- 13.4 The contractor shall in respect of labour employed by him or his sub-contractor comply with or cause to be complied with the contractor labour Regulation in regards to all matters provided therein.
- 13.5 The Contractor shall comply with the provisions of the payment of wages Act, 1936, Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Employers' Liability Act, 1938. Workmen's compensation Act, 1923, Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, Maternity Benefit Act, 1970 or any modification thereof or any other law relating thereto and rules made there under from time to time.
- 13.6 The workers/technician who is deputed for repair and maintenance work should carry with him all norms of Industrial safety.

13.6 The EPFO shall not indemnify against:

- i) Any claim arising out of third party loss/damage to life or property caused by /during execution of the work.
- ii) Any claim arising out of loss/damage to the workmen engaged by the contractor during execution of the work.
- iii) Any claim due to non-compliance of applicable PF/Labour laws, ESI regulations etc.
- iv) The contractor shall be responsible for indemnifying for the above.

14 Income tax/WCT/VAT Income tax/GST

Income tax/WCT/VAT income tax including surcharge if any, at the prevailing rate shall be deducted from the contractor's bill as per the provision of Income Tax Act. The contractor shall ascertain from the concerned commercial tax department regarding the applicability of works contract Tax /VAT/ TIN. Necessary deductions will be made from the contractor's bill as applicable. Any other Tax as applicable as per prevailing rates will be applicable.

- 15. **REVIEW OF CONTRACT:** The performance of the firm shall be reviewed in every quarter and if the performance is not found satisfactorily, the contract will be terminated by giving of 15 days notice.
- 16. **Tool and plants:** The required tools and plants for carrying out the work shall have to be arranged by the Contractor at his cost and no tools will be arranged by EPFO. The Contractor shall keep all required tools at site.
- 17. The decision of the RPFC of EPFO in all matters of the Contract shall be final and binding on both the parties.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1 AMC of split Type Air Conditioner units shall include supply of all material spares, replacement /repairs of compressor apart from the warranty compressor applicable AC units, gas charging, air filter, electrical parts, servicing, overhauling, greasing, starting relay, overload protector, wiring repairs, motor rewinding with bush and shaft, tapes including handling charges, blower motor/outdoor fan motor, digital scanner, piping, insulation and spares of outdoor/indoor units replacement etc., complete in all respects, for ensuing the desired levels of cooling.
- 2 If required by this office, AMC agency shall also provide full time mechanic & assistant during summer season for a specific period (one or two months) and payment will be paid separately as per Minimum Wages Act 1948.
- 3 This Annual Maintenance Contract shall be a Comprehensive contract for different types of air conditioners and for difference types of maintenance.
- 4 The air conditioners that are not serviceable by the agency/beyond economical repair due to obsolescence of technology or non-availability of parts/Components/assemblies will be withdrawn from the maintenance contract. Withdrawal of such air conditioners shall be communicated to the agency and equivalent maintenance charges shall be deducted from the amount due to the agency. Preventive maintenance service would be carried out by the service provider regularly to keep the equipment running in the trouble-free condition during the period of contract as also wash the filter of all the ACs every month.
- 5 A record of preventive maintenance carried out would be maintained by the agency and certified by the authorized officer. The contractor will maintain history sheet of equipments under maintenance contract with detailed specification.
- 6 All the faults will be attended at site of EPFO. In case of a major fault, if the machine is required to be taken to the company workshop, the company shall provide a replacement unit till the time the AC sent for repairs is positioned back.
- 7 Details of all minor/major, routine/preventive repair/maintenance job undertaken shall be entered into the history sheet.
- 8 Besides periodic servicing of the ACs, contract shall include attending the breakdown calls, providing and fixing of any components of the machine (free of cost) viz. starting capacitor, running capacitor, thermostat, over load relay, selector switch, indicator, nuts, bolts, screws, motor leaking, part wiring or complete wiring of AC (internally), supplying and charging of refrigerant gas, providing and replacement of compressor with new one or manufacturer repaired compressor (no cut weld/locally repaired compressor will be accepted as replacement) apart from the warranty compressor applicable Air conditioner units, repairing of the insulation/pipes of split ACs, etc. to ensure that ACs function in proper way.

Time schedule and periodicity of work

Work to be carried out monthly:

Cleaning of filters of all the air conditioners to conserve the energy and checking of current drawn by each AC to know the healthy condition of the ACs

Note: Repairing, etc. is to be done immediately if on inspection any defect is found.

Work to be carried out on Quarterly:

Quarterly Preventive Maintenance shall include the following: Checking motor bushings. Ground connections. Checking connections at the main plug. Cleaning of blower and condenser fan. Cleaning the evaporator and condenser coils. Cleaning the equipment. Checking and tightening of nuts & bolts. Oiling the motor. checking cooling efficiency. Overhauling of the A/c with chemical washing process.

However, the air filter of the Air-conditioning Units shall be cleaned every month of the quarter.

Break-down service (BDS):-

Breakdown calls shall be attended to immediately and a record of such service, duly acknowledged by the person in charge of the location of the air-conditioner, shall be maintained. Breakdown service will include replacement of genuine spares & Compressor and Gas filling at the cost of the service provider.

ANNUAL MAINTENANCE SERVICE (ONCE A YEAR)

The scope of work shall include all checks and tests as detailed under routine maintenance services. In addition annual maintenance services shall also include.

- a) Cleaning the condenser and evaporator coils with suitable detergent/chemical solution and flushing with high-pressure jet of water.
- b) Greasing of blower motors and all moving parts,
- c) Prevention of rusting of units
- d) The ACs installed are of Hitachi, Voltas and other brand. In off season there is during the lean period of winter the contractor shall attend all the Air conditioner units for major attentions and keep the equipment ready for use for the next summer.

Exclusion of contract

The following shall not be a part of this contract: Electronic remote control, Voltage Stabilizer, all plastic components, element, Front Grill, Bottom Tray, Cabinet cover and sheet metal parts and Shifting charges of Split type AC units. If re-fixing/dismantling of AC units required by this office, AMC agency shall also attend the said work and payment of shifting charges will be paid separately.

9. The penalty amount per complaint will be as follows:

- I) Fault not rectified within 24 hours @ Rs 200/- per day.
- II) Major faults not rectified within 48 hours @ Rs 500/- per day.
- III) If OEM or above specification component is not used as maintenance spare, the cost of the equipment will be paid by the vendor if the equipment becomes unserviceable.
- IV) Any delay beyond 10 days in rectifying the major fault, the penalty will be enhanced to Rs 1000/- per day.

- V) Beyond 15 days if the equipment gets repaired in the open market, the actual cost of the same shall be recovered from the contractor, In extreme cases, the action of forfeiture of security money/pending bill/blacklisting of the firm can be resorted at the discretion of the competent authority.
 - VI) Any damage to the building or the any part of the equipment which might result during the operations shall be repaired by the contractor.
 - VII) In case any employee found absent from his duty following recovery shall be made from the contractor's bill a) Mechanic @ 300/- per day b) Assistant/Helper @ Rs 200/- per day Mechanic should have his mobile phone at the time of Duty at EPFO.
 - VIII) Any damage resulting to the system on account of the negligence or mail operation shall be made good by the contractor. Nothing extra will be paid for such work.
 - IX) The contractor shall arrange to render efficient service as outlined in this specification. However, in case the contractor fails to maintain the service to the satisfaction of the Officer-in-Charge of the department and any expenditure incurred therein for alternative arrangements by the Officer-in - Charge shall be recovered from the contractor.
10. The contractor or his representative should no remove, disturb, and dislocate the existing equipment and its parts from its positions until and unless it is authorized by the Officer-in Charge. The entire installation should be intact at any time of inspection as well as handed over to him at the time of initial taking over of its maintenance and operation. Care shall also be taken not to damage installation by improper handling.
 11. The material requires replacement shall be of same quality/manufacturer and specifications. The dismantled material shall be the property of contractor.
 12. All break-down calls shall be attended to immediately and on the same day. Breakdown calls that could not be attended to on the same day for exceptional reasons shall be attended to on the next day without fail.
 13. Transportation of Air conditioner units from the office buildings to the service provider's workshop, from one building to another and from the service provider's workshop to the office buildings, will be at the cost of the service provider.
 14. The Service provider is responsible for the payment of Minimum Wages (under Central Act) to the personnel deployed by it. The service provider is also responsible for compliance of the provisions of all the statutes applicable in its case.
 15. Cancellation of contract in cases of poor workmanship and non-compliance of tender/agreement or services provided by the contractor are not found to be satisfactory, the contract shall be terminated by the department by giving 10 days' notice even before the expiry of contract period and shall be forfeited the security deposit without assigning any reason what so ever.
